ABOUT PROJECT

The “**Leadership in Youthwork 101**” project aims to fundamentally enhance the leadership capabilities of representatives from 9 countries. The main goal is to enhance their **leadership and strategic skills**, equip them with practical tools for vision setting, team motivation and effective **decision making**

The project will involve developing practical hands- on skills in risk and crisis management and also will empower young leaders to **take initiative** and step out of their comfort zone.

Participants should be **young leaders** and **youth workers** aged 18 to 30 years old who are active in their organizations. If possible, organizations should select participants with fewer opportunities.



VENUE & TRAVEL

The project will take place at **Vihorlat Resort** hotel in Snina, Slovakia. You will need to travel to **Snina** and you can do so via train from Košice. Before purchasing any tickets, please contact us to confirm your itinerary and means of transport.

Participants will be accommodated in rooms for 2-4 people and will have 3 meals a day in the hotel restaurant. There is free WiFi available. Learn more at www.vihorlatresort.sk.

PREPARATION

Each participant will have to complete a **pre-project needs questionnaire**. Participants should prepare a short, creative **presentation** about their home organization's activities.

The project includes a **2-day outdoor activity** consisting of 25 km hike and sleeping in tents. Before the project, we will share a list with all the **mandatory equipment** needed for the activity, such as backpack, sleeping bag, waterproof clothes and outdoor boots, personal medication and more.

Each national team must also prepare for **intercultural evening** where they will present their country's traditions, customs and local food through interactive programme.



REIMBURSEMENT

Food, accommodation, travel and activities are **fully covered**. Travel costs will be reimbursed upon receiving valid PDF or physical tickets (no screenshots). Taxi and first-class transport are ineligible.

Reimbursement per person:

Romania, Czechia, Lithuania:	417€ (green travel)
Serbia, Hungary:	285€ (green travel)
Greece, Italy:	309€ (standard travel)
Spain:	395€ (standard travel)

ADDITIONAL INFO

The weather is expected to be good and hot during this time of the year, but **don't underestimate** how cold can it be in the woods during an outdoor activity. We strongly encourage you to get some very warm, as well as rainproof clothes.

Slovakia uses **EURO (€)** as its currency. You will be able to pay with card pretty much everywhere except some small local shops and restaurants.



PROJECT OUTCOMES

Upon returning home, participants will be tasked with implementing their “**Community Leadership Action Plan**”, a specific six-month strategy for their organization.

Each national group is obliged to organize at least one **practical dissemination event**, such as presentation or an interactive workshop within their local community.

Participants will be required to take part in **online check-in** meetings to share the progress of their dissemination. They will also be responsible for sharing the project's public **digital toolkit** within their local youth work networks.
